100 Point CheckProving your Identity

When a person is required to provide a completed form B319 *Registering as a client in the Integrated Cargo System* to the Australian Border Force (ABF), they are also required to establish proof of identity through the 100 point check. You must establish your identity by providing documents from the list below that add up to a minimum of 100 points.

You must provide at least one form of photographic identification from the primary or secondary document lists.

If a document is not in English it must be accompanied by an official translation of the document from a National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI) accredited provider.

Primary Documents							
NOTE: One document must be supplied from this category. No additional points for multiple documents.

Secondary D Point Value	NOTE: One document from each point category can be used for the additional point score.

25 points	Document – must have a name and address on Electoral Roll compiled by the Australian Electoral Commission and available for public scrutiny Records of public utility - phone, water, gas, electricity bill Records of a financial institution A record held under a law other than a law relating to land titles
25 points	Document – must have a name and address on Rent/Lease agreement Rent receipt from a licensed real estate agent
25 points	Document – must have a name and date of birth on Record of a primary, secondary or tertiary educational institution attended by you within the last 10 years Record of professional or trade association of which you are a member
