REMITS Passed at 2022 TSNZ AGM

1.A.1.1 – Capitations

OLD RULE:

1.A.1.1 Capitations are those fees paid by an individual who has participated in target rifle shooting for a period in excess of six weeks in any capitation year, at a Club or Association affiliated to TSNZ. Payment of such Capitation Fees shall qualify an individual to become, or remain, an Ordinary Member of TSNZ.

BECAME:

1.A.1.1 Capitations are those fees paid by an individual who has participated in target rifle shooting for a period in excess of six weeks in any capitation year, at a Club or Association affiliated to TSNZ. Payment of such Capitation Fees shall qualify an individual to become, or remain, an Ordinary Member of TSNZ. A capitation year is the period from 1 April to 31 March.

1.A.1.3 – Capitations

OLD RULE:

1.A.1.3 The dates by which Capitation Fees shall be forwarded to TSNZ shall be:

- (i) Outdoor and Air Rifle Clubs - 31 December in the year of the Annual General Meeting;
- (ii) Indoor Clubs - 30 April of the year immediately after the Annual General Meeting.

BECAME:

1.A.1.3 The dates by which Capitation Fees, for the current capitation year, shall be forwarded to TSNZ shall be:

- (i) All Club members - 30 April

1.A.1.4 – Capitations

OLD RULE:

1.A.1.4 Members nominating for Inter-Island teams who have not paid the TSNZ Capitation Fee through an Outdoor Club during the current capitation year, shall forward the appropriate fee to reach the TSNZ office not later than 30 April.

BECAME:

1.A.1.4 Members nominating for Inter-Island teams shall pay the TSNZ Capitation Fee by 30 April.

1.A.2.2 – Affiliations

OLD RULE:

1.A.2.2 Outdoor and Air Rifle Club affiliation fees, together with details of club membership entered on the Club Membership Form provided by TSNZ, shall be forwarded to TSNZ by the affiliating Club not later than 31 December in each year.

BECAME:

1.A.2.2 Outdoor Club affiliation fees, together with details of club membership entered on the Club Membership Form provided by TSNZ, shall be forwarded to TSNZ by the affiliating Club not later than 31 October in each year.

1.A.2.3 – Affiliations – submitted by the Executive

OLD RULE:

1.A.2.3 Indoor Club affiliation fees, together with details of club membership entered on the Club Membership Form provided by TSNZ, shall be forwarded to TSNZ by affiliating Clubs not later than 30 April in each year.

BECAME:

1.A.2.3 Indoor and Air Rifle Club affiliation fees, together with details of club membership entered on the Club Membership Form provided by TSNZ, shall be forwarded to TSNZ by affiliating Clubs not later than 30 April in each year.

1.12.4 – Fees

OLD RULE:

1.12.4 Fees: Capitation Fees, Affiliation Fees, Levies and any other Fee (hereafter referred to as Fees) as may be determined by the TSNZ Annual General Meeting, shall cover the period of 1 January to 31 December of the year immediately after the Annual General Meeting.

BECAME:

1.12.4 Fees: Capitation Fees, Affiliation Fees, Levies and any other Fee (hereafter referred to as Fees) as may be determined by the TSNZ Annual General Meeting, shall cover the 12 month period of the year immediately after the Annual General Meeting.

2.13.2.1 – Inter-Island Competition - Nomination

OLD RULE:

2.13.2.1 Members who wish to nominate for selection to any of the teams in Rule 2.13.1 shall complete the panel on the TSNZ Membership form and return to the TSNZ office not later than 30 April in the year of the event. The current TSNZ Capitation Fee must be forwarded with the membership form if not previously paid through an Outdoor Club.

BECAME:

2.13.2.1 Members who wish to nominate for selection to any of the teams in Rule 2.13.1 shall complete their nomination and submit it to the TSNZ office not later than 30 April in the year of the event. A nomination is only valid if the Member, at the time nominations close (30 April), is a current financial TSNZ member for the capitation year of the event.

2.13.2.1 - Inter-Island Competition – Nomination

OLD RULE:

2.13.2.1 Members who wish to nominate for selection to any of the teams in Rule 2.13.1 shall complete the panel on the TSNZ Membership form and return to the TSNZ office not later than 30 April in the year of the event. The current TSNZ Capitation Fee must be forwarded with the membership form if not previously paid through an Outdoor Club.

BECAME:

2.13.2.1 Members may only nominate for the specific Island Teams that correlate to that Member's usual place of residence on 1 April in the year of the event i.e. if you live in the North Island you may only nominate for North Island Teams and if you live in the South Island you may only nominate for South Island Teams.
