Host Association

Please ensure the information form is completed and returned as per the instructions as soon as possible but no later than 30 July 2018.

Shooting Venue

Saxton Range, Saxton Field 921Main Road, Stoke (the large brown building, opposite cricket oval – behind the Nelson Cricket practise nets)

Accommodation

Accommodation has been arranged for shooters at the Saxton Lodge, 103 Saxton Road East, Stoke, which is not far from the shooting venue. The rooms are double/twin with some larger rooms that can sleep 3-4. The cost will be approximately \$55 per night per shooter and finalisation of cost will be confirmed when numbers and requirements are confirmed. Please note on your form whom you would like to share with and we will accommodate you where we can.

Transportation and Airport Collection

TS Nelson has arranged transportation from the Airport to the Saxton Lodge providing we receive all the flight information, ie date, flight number and time of arrival.

Transportation of you and your gear from Saxton Lodge to the Range will be provided by TS Nelson and you will be advised further regarding this at the information evening on the Friday night.

Dinner and Prizegiving

Team photos (at 6pm) and the dinner (at 7.30pm) will be held at Club Waimea, 345 Queen Street, Richmond on the Sunday evening. Transportation will be arranged for those needing it and you will be advised regarding this at the information evening on the Friday night.

Please note – the dinner is a formal occasion and men will be required to wear a jacket and tie, the ladies suitable evening attire.

Information for All Shooters in the North vs South Match

- 1. When selected for the team please return your travel and accommodation details as soon as possible, even if you are arriving by your own transport and don't need to be met. The more information the Host Association has, the easier the job will be. When filling out your accommodation details, please note if you wish to share with a particular person, but be aware that it may not always be possible due to room details. Make sure you state whether you are left or right handed.
- 2. Travelling on domestic airlines advise the airline in advance that you are travelling with a firearm and ammunition. Ammunition and your bolt should be carried separately from your rifle. We suggest you wrap your ammunition in a secure box and pack it in your sports bag, with your bolt, which must be checked in with your other luggage. The rifle case could then be taped across the hinges/locks. Make sure the rifle is securely packed, as airlines aren't as careful with them as you are. Your mat can be strapped to your bag or rifle case. Airlines have a limit on bags and if fully booked, will unload a bag if you have more than one.
- **3.** The team introduction and opening on the Friday night is an integral part of the whole weekend. Please make sure that your travel arrangements allow you to attend. If there is a genuine reason why you can't attend the introduction, you must let your team Manager know in advance so he/she can put in your apology.
- 4. A black blazer or jacket and tie will be needed for the photographs on the Sunday night. You may be able to borrow from another shooter on the night but you can't borrow a blazer with the NZ emblem on it unless you have been in the New Zealand team at some stage. Attendance at the photograph session is compulsory. Please do not be late. Dress code for the dinner is semi formal; tie and light coloured shirt expected for men (no jeans); for women any skirts/dresses worn are expected to be of a length that is suitable when seated in photographs.
- 5. Shooting depending on range conditions, practice may be available on the Friday night, but this is not always possible. Please read the timetable you are given and make sure you allow plenty of time to prepare. Sometimes the mound draw will be done before you arrive so you can practice on the mound you will shoot on. Shooting mats are available for use at the range. A large locked cupboard is available at range for rifle storage.
- 6. The Inter Island competition is 10 20, 10 shot on our standard targets. Make yourself aware of any special range conditions that could be announced at the Friday night briefing (another reason to attend). The range calls could be different to what you are used to, so be prepared. Check your targets for marking or adding errors when you have shot. (Remember a shot that has already been tested can't be retested.) Any queries on the marking should be brought to the attention of your Manager, who will forward your protest to the Chief Marker. The official protest time ends 20 minutes after the final team score for your match has been posted.
- 7. **On the Sunday** match conditions may vary. All matches on the Sunday will be shot on TSNZ cards. Limited practice will be available for this match but times will vary. The shooters who did not make the NZ teams will have a separate team competition. This may vary from year to year. The match conditions will be notified by the TSNZ Executive before the North vs South weekend.
