## 2024 TSNZ Inter-Secondary Schools Inter Island Match

To be held at the Blenheim Smallbore Rifle Club Range, Brewer St, Blenheim

7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> September 2024

### Match Information

#### Schools teams match

Team of three shooters from the same school, each shooting 3 x 10 shot cards. Up to 2 teams per school – a **Competition Team and a Development Team**. The winning team will be awarded individual medals and prize vouchers and the Eddie Love Trophy, the top three individual shooters will receive medals and prize vouchers, and all shooters will receive certificates.

#### Inter Island teams match

**The top 10 shooters from each Island's Competition Teams**, based on their scores in the Schools team match, will qualify for their respective Island teams. The 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> scorers will be the team emergencies. All Island team members (including emergencies) will shoot 2 x 10 shot cards. The winning team will receive medals and the Ian Greenhough Memorial trophy.

#### New Zealand teams

**The top 12 shooters from all Competition Teams**, based on the aggregates of their scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match, will form the New Zealand team to shoot postal targets against Great Britain on Sunday morning. All team members will shoot 2 x 10 shot cards, with the top 10 shooters' scores to count for the team total.

#### Plate match

All shooters not involved in the New Zealand team match will be drawn into teams, and shoot 2 x 10 shot matches for additional awards.

#### Individual awards

Trophies will be awarded to the top Girl and top Boy Competition Team shooters, based on the aggregates of scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match. Awards will go to top Girl and top Boy Development Team shooters from the Schools team match.

### General Information

#### Accommodation

Schools are responsible for arranging their own accommodation.

#### Range information

The range is a 12 mound, 25 yard range situated in Athletic Park at the end of Brewer St, Blenheim.

#### Food and drink
