## 2021 AIR RIFLE CHALLENGE

This Competition runs over 6 months, from 1st July 2021 to 31st December 2021, with one match to be shot each month.

The score (in decimals) for each match must be at the TSNZ Office by the last day of each month.

At least 4 matches must be shot to be eligible for Awards.

Scores from official TSNZ matches are eligible if they are declared to be part of this competition to the Range Officer in advance.

## AWARDS

- 1 **Top Shooter** in each Section - the total of the best 4 scores from the 6 possible matches
- 2 **Top Single Match Score** in each Section
- 3 **Top 10-Shot String** in each Section
- 4 **Most Improved** in each Section - the percentage difference of the last match shot compared to the average of all the previous matches

**Sections: MEN / WOMEN / JUNIOR MEN / JUNIOR WOMEN / NEW SHOOTER**

(Junior = under 21 as at 31 December 2021) (New Shooter = started shooting Air Rifle after 1 October 2020)

**The score from each match will be included in as many Sections as may apply to the shooter.**

## COMPETITION CONDITIONS

**TSNZ Rules of Air Rifle Competition apply.**

**Range:** Any 10m Air rifle range may be used, however if shot at anything other a range currently used by TSNZ, the range distance must be measured and confirmed as 10 metres by a Witness before shooting commences.

**Witnesses:** All matches must be witnessed while they are shot, either in person or by electronic means (eg Zoom).  
 Names of Witnesses must be included with the results for each match and Witnesses may be contacted by TSNZ.

<b>Paper targets:</b>	<p>Must have Challenge Match stickers applied to the first and last target before any shooting commences.</p> <p>Must be marked in decimals by an electronic marking system. If posting targets in, take account of NZ Post times.</p> <p>May be sent to TSNZ for marking, in which case targets must be at the TSNZ Office by the last day of the month.</p>
<b>Electronic targets:</b>	<p>Must have the match declared to the Witness to be a Challenge Match before any shooting commences.</p> <p>Must use a type of electronic target approved by TSNZ.</p> <p>Must have a photo of the final screen showing date, match total, and 10-shot strings, sent to TSNZ as proof of score.</p>

Each month rankings and results of Awards 2 - 4 from that month's scores will be announced.

**FINAL RESULTS - At the end of the Competition** PRIZE MONEY will be awarded to the WINNER of each of the Awards 1 - 4 from all scores shot (amount depending on entries), and CERTIFICATES will be awarded to the TOP THREE PLACINGS for each.
