2023 TSNZ Inter-Secondary Schools Inter Island Match

Match Information

Following the success of the 2022, we are again holding this match at a range of venues around NZ. The match will be held on one day only, and this year the Plate Match will be held. Scores will be sent in to TSNZ from all venues and collated during the day so regular updates can be given and Island and NZ teams can be selected.

Schools teams match

Team of three shooters from the same school, each shooting 3×10 shot cards. Multiple teams can be entered from each school. The winning team will be awarded individual medals and prize vouchers and the Eddie Love Trophy, the top three individual shooters will receive medals and prize vouchers, and all competitors will receive certificates.

<u>Inter Island teams match</u>

The top 10 shooters from each Island, based on their scores in the Schools team match will qualify for their respective Island teams. The 11^{th} and 12^{th} scorers will be the team emergencies. All Island team members (including emergencies) will shoot 2 x 10 shot cards. The winning team will receive medals and the Ian Greenhough Memorial trophy.

New Zealand teams

The top 12 shooters, based on the aggregates of their scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match, will form the New Zealand team to shoot postal targets against Great Britain. All team members will shoot 2×10 shot cards, with the top 10 shooters' scores to count for the team total.

Plate match

All shooters not involved in the New Zealand team match will be drawn into teams and shoot 2 x 10 shot matches for additional awards.

Individual awards

Trophies will be awarded to the Top Girl, and Top Boy, based on the aggregates of scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match.

Trophies, medals and certificates will be delivered after the event for presentation at schools.

General Information

Six ranges are hosting this match in 2023, and when they enter schools nominate which range they will shoot at. Note that changes may need to be made if too few or too many schools are planning to be at any one range, and any schools affected will be contacted after entries have closed to arrange the best possible solution for them.

Details of range facilities, match times, squadding etc will vary between ranges, and will be forwarded to each school after entries have closed.
