GENERAL INFORMATION:

Entries:

Entries are required to be received (including payment) no later than Friday 4th February 2022 and final squad numbers will be determined at that time. Late entries will only be accepted if there is available space and will incur a late fee. A requirement of entry is that you must be a financial member of Target Shooting NZ. International visitors must be a financial member of your relevant National Shooting Federation and hold all relevant licenses to enable you to compete. You will be required to arrange import permits and other required paperwork from the relevant New Zealand Authority, and must comply with all relevant COVID19 conditions.

Event Fees: We are endeavouring to try and offset some of the costs. TSHV may refund a portion of the entry fee depending on the outcome and the budget.

Squadding details and start times:

These will be provided after the close of entries.

Shooting mats:

If you have your own, please bring it. There are a small number of mats available at the range, which will be available on a first in first served basis to borrow.

Rifles:

There will not be a lockup provided at the range for rifles, you will need to take responsibility for your own equipment. If you are an international competitor, please contact Ross Mason on the above email address to arrange a suitable club 'buddy' to help you.

Juniors:

Juniors must be under 21 years of age on the 31st of December 2022 to qualify for Junior teams and awards. Scores shot will count for both the Junior and Women's/Men's matches.

Veterans:

Veterans must be 60 years of age or over before the 22nd of February 2022 to qualify for Veterans awards.

Grades:

Grades are as follows for your average score for a 10 shot string:

A Grade	97.00-100	This would equate to scores of 582/600 or above
B Grade	95.00-96.99	This would equate to scores between 570 and 581/600
C Grade	92.50-94.99	This would equate to scores between 555 and 569/600
D Grade	Up to 92.49	This would equate to scores of 554 and below

North Island, South Island and New Zealand Teams and Aggregate Trophies:

To be able to be selected for these teams and awards, you must be a TSNZ member resident in NZ and compete in three matches – both graded matches and the Nationals 50m match.

North Island and South Island Teams

The top 11 aggregate scores from each island will be selected for the North and South Island teams including 1 emergency in each.

New Zealand Teams

The top 10 aggregate scores will be selected for the Wakefield team

The top 22 aggregate scores will be selected for the Slazenger team including 2 emergencies

The top 5 women aggregate scores will be selected for the Women's team

The top 3 junior aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior team

The top 3 junior men aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Men Drew team

The top 3 junior women aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Women Drew team

The top 10 junior aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Drew team

The top 12 women aggregate scores who wish to be considered will be selected for the Women's Randle team including 2 emergencies – TBC closer to the event

Outdoor National Championship (Individual Trophies/Medals):

Will be presented as per the TSNZ Trophy Steward's list.

Venues:

The range is situated at the Allen Range, Dante Rd, Trentham.

Dinner and presentations are at the Trentham Racecourse. From South: Turn off SH2 at Silverstream. Continue approx. 2km on Ferguson Dr and at lights turn right onto Sutherland Venue.

From North: Turn left off SH2 at "Trentham/Heretaunga" sign onto Moonshine Rd. Turn right onto Ferguson Dr at lights. Left at lights onto Sutherland Ave.



COMPETITOR INFORMATION:

This event is completely dependent on the Governments instructions for COVID mitigation.

Registration:

All competitors must register their attendance at the Allen Range and sign the range standing rules form on arrival. A start card will be included in your entry pack for you to record your squadding details on and results of an optional equipment check.

Equipment checks:

Equipment checks are optional and can be done at the range on Saturday 19th and Sunday 20st February from 12pm. Please see Evan from the TSNZ office if you would like equipment checks after this day/time so it can be arranged.

Squadding information:

All squad lists will be displayed on the wall in the gear set up area within the range. Please check that you are listed. If there are problems, please advise Ross Mason, Christine Edney or Evan Little. Also on the notice board will be the expected start times for each squad and the mound draw, and any changes to match/selection conditions that may apply.

Shots per target:

50m Prone	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 shots per diagram for the match, 1 shot per diagram for the finals.• 1 lead in target, 4 sighting targets, competition targets, 1 lead out target
Three position	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 shots per diagram for the match, 1 shot per diagram for the finals.• 1 lead in target, 4 sighting targets for each position, competition targets, 1 lead out target
Assn teams	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 shots per diagram for the match,• 1 lead in target, 2 sighters, competition targets, 1 lead out target for each team member

Results:

Official Results will be posted at the Trentham Golf Club close to the marking room, where the necessary protest time will be observed. Targets can be collected and checked at the same location. Copies of confirmed results from previous days will be displayed on the board outside the marking room, the range and will be posted on the TSNZ website.

Practice:

Practice can take place on Saturday afternoon after 3P and Sunday (19/20 February) afternoon after 3P Finals, or by arrangement throughout the week (see Ross or CRO to arrange this). The cost for practices will be \$15, to cover target and range fees. Payable at the Range.

Equipment Preparation

Shelter will be provided for equipment preparation close to the firing point. No rifle cases will be allowed on the firing point. Essential shooting equipment only on the FP.

Benchrest & Personal Flags:

Bench rest will run at a set time throughout the week. First Benchrest squad will start at 3pm each day (Tuesday to Friday). The range will have multiple bays set up for shooters to complete in this event. Benches and chairs will be available. Feel free to bring your own chair.

Mounds will be drawn before the first day and competitors will move two Firing Points each day and will swap details each day – if more than one detail is required.

You will be required to shoot 4 x 40 shot matches.

Personal wind flags will be permitted to be used on the range. The existing flags and poles will not be moved or removed.

Volunteers:

We thank those that have already volunteered to help run the TSNZ National Championships in Upper Hutt. As with any event, support from fellow shooters is much appreciated. If you would like to help in any way, then please reach out to one of the TSHV committee members, or speak with Ross or Christine or fill out the entry form at the bottom to volunteer.

Womens Randle Match:

TSHV is arranging to run a Randle team match on the 100m Heretaunga Pistol Club Range. this is still being worked through with HPC, so will be confirmed closer to the event being run – please look out for these updates shortly.

COVID requirements:

Depending on the COVID alert level, TSHV will amend the squad lists to meet the TSNZ COVID range requirements. The range has walls between each Firing Point. This may mean that shooters are not necessarily squadded every other bay. If required the programme will be amended and posted in advance to the completion to alert athletes of any changes closer to the event being run.

Accommodation

There are a number of motels in Upper Hutt. Usual internet search will find them.

NZ Campus of Innovation & Sport (NZCIS)
