

Notification of exempted sporting firearms export

It is a requirement to notify exempted sporting firearms exports.

Pursuant to New Zealand’s export control regime, private persons are able to export from New Zealand up to five sporting firearms and associated ammunition without a permit from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade. However, while such exports are exempted from permitting requirements, all such exports should still be notified to MFAT using this notification form. The purpose of this notification requirement is to enable MFAT to meet its international reporting requirement under the United Nations Arms Trade Treaty. The information provided in this declaration will be used (only) for that purpose.
