Entries:

Entries are required no later than 31st January 2019 and final squad numbers will be determined at that time.

Late entries will only be accepted if there is available space and will incur a late fee.

Squadding details and start times:

These will be provided after the close of entries.

Shooting mats:

If you have your own, please bring it or advise if you need to borrow one from our club members.

Rifles:

There is no facility to lock up rifles at the range. You will need to take responsibility for your own equipment or ask a Christchurch shooter very nicely if you are worried.

Juniors:

Juniors must be under 21 years of age on the 31st of December 2019 to qualify for Junior teams and awards. Scores shot will count for both the Junior and Womens/Mens matches.

Veterans:

Veterans must be 60 years of age or over before the 20th of February 2019 to qualify for Veterans awards.

Grades:

Grades are as follows for your average score for a 10 shot string.

A Grade	97.00-100	This would equate to scores of 582/600 or above
B Grade	95.00-96.99	This would equate to scores between 570 and 581/600
C Grade	92.50-94.99	This would equate to scores between 555 and 569/600
D Grade	up to 92.49	This would equate to scores of 554 and below

North Island, South Island and New Zealand Teams and Aggregate Trophies:

To be able to be selected for these teams and awards, you must compete in three matches - both the graded matches and the Nationals 50m match.

North Island and South Island Teams

The top 11 aggregate scores from each island will be selected for the North and South Island teams including 1 emergency in each.

New Zealand Teams

The top 22 aggregate scores will be selected for the Slazenger team including 2 emergencies
The top 10 aggregate scores will be selected for the Wakefield team

The top 5 women aggregate scores will be selected for the Women's team
 The top 3 junior aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior team
 The top 3 junior men aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Men Drew team
 The top 3 junior women aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Women Drew team
 The top 10 junior aggregate scores will be selected for the Junior Drew team.

Aggregate Trophies

The top aggregate score from each grade will win the Graded Aggregate trophies. (A, B, C, and D grades)

The top aggregate score from the Benchrest and Graded Matches will win the Dudley Jarman Memorial Trophy.

North Canterbury Miniature Rifle Association would like to welcome you to the 2019 TSNZ Outdoor National Championships in Christchurch. We would especially like to welcome our overseas visitors and thank them for their support. NCMRA wishes you have a wonderful time while you are staying in the "Garden City" and trust that you will enjoy its many sites and offerings between matches.

1. Registration

All competitors must register their attendance at the kitchen where they will receive their competitor pack. A start card will be included in the pack for you to record your squadding details on and results of an optional equipment check.

2. Equipment checks

Equipment checks are optional and can be done at the range on Tuesday 19th between 9.30am and 2.30pm

3. Squadding information

All squad lists will be displayed on the wall outside the marking room. Please check that you are listed. If there are any problems, please advise either Sarah or Adrian Black, or Jackie Lindsay.

Also advertised on the notice board are expected start times for each squad and the mound draw.

4. Shots per target / arrangement of targets

50 Metre Prone - 2 shots per diagram for the match, 1 shot per diagram for finals.
1 lead in target, 4 sighting targets, competition targets, 1 lead out target.

Three Position - 2 shots per diagram for the match, 1 shot per diagram for finals.
1 lead in target, 4 sighting targets, competition targets, 1 lead out target.

Assn Teams - 2 shots per diagram
For each member - 1 lead in target, 2 sighting targets, competition targets, 1 lead out target

5. Target machines

The target machines can go forwards and backwards, however it is recommended to take care when reversing (or avoid it) as it can rip the targets. If there is a problem with your machine during the match, please advise the range officer immediately. If the problem cannot be fixed quickly, then you will be moved to another firing point.

Shooters are not to advance targets until they have been called to the line.

6. Food

A kitchen will be set up at the range with a selection of food, home baking and drinks. Please make the most of this.

7. Presentations

Presentations for 3P and Prone National Championships will be held after the event/final at the Range.

8. Team Photographs & Presentation dinner

Team photographs will be at the Russley Golf Club in the Terrace Room (Memorial Ave, Christchurch) starting at 5.30pm. The dress code is formal with black blazers, dark trousers, white shirt and dark tie for men and knee length or below dress/skirt for women if not wearing pants.

Photos will be \$21 each plus \$4 shipping if purchased on the night, or can be purchased later from the photographer's website for \$26 plus shipping.

Dinner will follow the photos with presentations and speeches made between and after the courses. Please advise on your entry form if you have any dietary requirements. It will be a buffet main with gluten free options included and an alternate plate drop for dessert.

9. Results

Results will be displayed on the wall outside the marking room and targets can be collected from the bench beside the door. Copies of results from previous days will be displayed on the board near the changing room and toilets and will be posted on the North Canterbury Miniature Rifle Club Facebook page and on the TSNZ website.

13. Practice

Practice can take place on Monday 18th after 3pm or by arrangement throughout the week. Please see Sarah or Adrian Black to organise this. Targets will cost \$10.

14. Bench Rest

Please book your time slots from those available. You will be required to shoot 2 x 60 shot matches. Bench rest booking sheets will be available to book at the kitchen when it is open or outside the marking room.
