3. FIREARMS LICENCE/STORAGE

The Firearms Licence provided by your State will be recognised in South Australia.

Due to changes to the SA Firearms Regulations 2017, it is not permitted for firearms to be stored at the TRSA State Range. Please be advised that all firearms and ammunition are to remain in the possession of individual members. All Firearm Licence holders with firearms who are not residing at the premises where their firearm is normally kept need to take appropriate precautions to ensure their firearms and ammunition are stored as safely as possible.

4. COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The Preliminary Competition Schedule is attached to this General Information The organiser reserves the right to change the timings.

Training times have been included in the program, with extra times available as time permits. All extra training will incur a range fee if the athlete has not been shooting in events on the day of the training.

5. VICTORY CEREMONY

The Victory Ceremonies will take place as specified in the schedule. During the ceremonies athletes are requested to present themselves in Club / State / National/International T-shirts where applicable, and long pants.

In the event you do not have a Club, State, National or International shirt, clothing attire at victory ceremony must be free of logos and branding.

6. ENTRIES AND SQUADDING INFORMATION

Bookings will open from 1st September 2024

Entry and Competition Conditions:

- Late entries will only be accepted if there is room for more entries and will incur a \$10 late entry fee per event.
- Range fees are payable for any extra training (except on days when the competitor has already paid to compete on that day).
- Squadding times may vary depending on entry numbers and time constraints.
- Entry in grades and other categories is included in the Open Entry Fee.
- Athletes wishing to share rifles may be accommodated in different relays if sufficient information is provided to the organising committee by email at the time of entry.
- All competitors must be members of TRA or similar international federation.
- TRSA and the TRA Board reserve the right to amend the program if necessary.
- Current membership card and Firearms Licence must be presented at the time of registration.
- Shooting mats will be provided. For ISSF matches, personal mats are not permitted.
- Finals for WSPS events will be held if there are 3 or more entrants in the events.
- Squadding information will be available on the TRA and TRSA website by Monday 24th March 2025.

5. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The National Championships will be conducted in accordance with ISSF and WSPS Rules in those events that are specified ISSF and WSPS (with the exception of the three-position match being conducted as an open event and not specifically men and women events). All other events will be conducted under TRA Australian Supplementary Rules.

The competition will be held on Meyton Electronic Scoring Targets on the 50m and 10m ranges, and on TRA approved paper targets on the 20m range.

Air or CO2 Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This will be checked by Equipment Control.

7. CANTEEN

Breakfast, snacks and lunch will be available for the duration of the National Championships.

9. EVENT DETAILS

ISSF Three Position

Three Position event, run according to ISSF rules, except will be open for men and women. 15 minutes sighting time in kneeling, followed by 90-minute competition beginning with 20 shot in each position of kneeling, prone and standing. Integer scoring.

Open final for top 8, to determine the National Champion. Categories – Open, Men, Women, Junior, Veteran, Open and Junior State Pairs Teams

WSPS Three Position (R7 & R8)

Three Position event, run according to WSPS rules. Time limit of 2 hours, 45 minutes, with 40 shots of kneeling, prone and standing.

Final for 3 or more athletes.

ISSF Men's/Women's Air Rifle

ISSF Air Rifle match format, all decimal scoring. Time: 15 min Prep& Sighting and 75 mins for 60 shot match.

Men's final to determine Men's match, and Women's final to determine Women's match.

WSPS R1, R2, R4 and VI Standing, shot as separate events, but in conjunction with the ISSF Air Rifle events.

Open Air Rifle

ISSF Air Rifle match format, all decimal scoring. Time: 15 min Prep& Sighting and 75 mins for 60 shot match. Open to Men, Women, SH1(R1 & R2) and VI Standing.

Open final to determine the National Champion (includes Junior, R1, R2, VIS.).

Categories – Open, Junior, Veteran, Grades, Open and Junior State Teams, Champion of State Air Rifle Champions.

Air Rifle Supported

TRA Supported 10m Air Rifle match. Decimal scoring. Time: 15 min Prep& Sighting and 50 mins for 60 shot match.

Categories – Open, Junior, Veteran, Grades.

Air Rifle Mixed Pairs

This match is shot using the ISSF rules for the structure of the competition – 10 mins sighters followed by 30 shots in 30 minutes. Pairs will be allocated by the organising committee and may consist of mixed or same gender pairs, depending on entries.

Final to follow with top 4 pairs – 3rd and 4th for the bronze medal match, and 1st and 2nd to the gold medal match. 5 mins sighters, followed by individual shots in 50 seconds – scoring 2 points for a win, 1 for a draw and 0 for a loss for each combined total of the shot for each pair. First pair to 16 points is the winner.

WSPS Air Rifle Prone R3, R5, VIP

This is a 60 shot air rifle prone match conducted for SH1, SH2 and VIP shooters, and conducted under WSPS Rules, 15 mins sighting time with 50 mins competition time for R3 and VIP, and 60mins for R5.

An Open Final for all WSPS prone events.

ISSF Prone

ISSF Prone format – decimal scoring, 15 mins sighting time, 50 min competition time. Open to Men and Women separately. No final in this match.

Including: Champion of State 50m Prone Championships, Open state team and Junior state teams.

Bill Eddy Dual Range Championship

This match is shot in the prone position and consists of 1×60 shots at 20 metres shot on Thursday, and 1×60 shots at 50 m (taken from day 1 of the Jim Smith Match – but scored in integer scoring)

Categories – on the total of both days (120 shots)- Open (which may include SH1 -R6 athletes), Men, Women, Junior, Veteran and Grades.

Benchrest Dual Range Championship

This match is shot in the benchrest position and consists of 1 x 60 shots at 20 metres shot on Friday, and 1 x 60 shots at 50 m (taken from day 1 of the 50m Benchrest Championship) but scored in integer scoring.

Categories – on the total of both days (120 shots) - Open (which may include SH1 -R6 athletes),, Men, Women, Junior, Veteran and Grades.

Jim Smith 50m Championship

This match consists of 2 x 60 shot prone matches, shot using decimal scoring but with 75 mins time limit that includes sighters (athlete presses match button when they are ready).

Day 1 is random squadding. Day 2 is squadding based on outcome of Day 1 (with higher scores in the same relay together).

Categories – on the total of both days (120 shots) - Open (which may include SH1 -R6 athletes), Men, Women, Junior, Veterans, and Grades. Scores on the first day of Jim Smith match to also be used in conjunction with the Bill Eddy Dual Range competition. The score will be counted twice (in decimal for the Jim Smith match and in integer for the Bill Eddy match to conform with the 20m scoring).

50m Benchrest Championship

This match consists of 2 x 60 shot benchrest matches, shot using decimal scoring but with 75 mins time limit that includes sighters (athlete presses match button when they are ready).

Day 1 is random squadding. Day 2 is squadding based on outcome of Day 1 (with higher scores in the same relay together). Day 2 includes Open State Team.

Scores on the first day of 50m Benchrest match will also be used in conjunction with the Dual Range Championship. The score will be counted twice (in decimal for the 50m Benchrest Championship match and in integer for the Dual Range Championship to conform with the 20m scoring).

Categories – on the total of both days (120 shots)- Open (which may include SH1 -R6 athletes), Men, Women, Junior, Veterans, and Grades.

The 4 Position Carnivale

A fun competition aimed at getting position, prone and benchrest shooters together on the firing point. Teams of 4 people, with each team member assigned one of the 4 positions to be conducted – prone, standing, kneeling or benchrest. Scoring in integer only.

Entries taken either as fully formed teams or individuals who would like to be included in a team. Entry will be reliant on the nominated team having one shooter for each position, and so some people may not be able to participate.
