Information for all Shooters in the Indoor Inter-Island Matches

- 1 When selected for the team, please return your travel and accommodation details as soon as possible, even if you are arriving by your own transport and don't need to be met. The more information the Host Association has, the easier the job will be.
- 2 Make sure you state whether you are left or right handed.
- 3 Travelling on domestic airlines: Ammunition and your bolt must be carried separately from your rifle. We suggest you wrap your ammunition in a secure box and pack it in your sports bag, with your bolt, which must be checked in with your other luggage. The rifle case could then be taped across the hinges/locks. Make sure the rifle is securely packed, as airlines aren't as careful with them as you are. Your mat could be strapped to your bag or rifle case. Airlines have a limit on bags and if fully booked, will unload a bag if you have more than one. A suggestion to ladies in particular, if you travel in clothes you can't shoot in, put your basic gear in with your sports gear, i.e. trousers, and nominate which bag you want sent first. (No point arriving with your knickers but no sports gear.) A tip for carrying your blazer wear it on the plane: (A) it promotes TSNZ (B) it makes you easier to identify at the airport.
- 4 The team introduction and opening on the Friday night is an integral part of the whole weekend. Please make sure that your travel arrangements allow you to attend. If there is a genuine reason why you can't attend the introduction, you must let your team Manager know in advance so he/she can put in your apology.
- 5 A black blazer or jacket and tie are required for the photographs on the Sunday night. You may be able to borrow from another shooter on the night, but you can't borrow a blazer with the NZ emblem on it unless you have been in the New Zealand team at some stage. Attendance at the photograph session is compulsory. Please don't be late. Dress code for the dinner is semi-formal; tie and light coloured shirt expected for men (no jeans or sports shoes).
- **6 Shooting:** Depending on range conditions, practice may be available on the Friday night, but this is not always possible. Please read the timetable you are given and make sure you allow plenty of time to prepare. Sometimes the mound draw will be done before you arrive so you can practice on the mound you will shoot on.
- 7 The Inter Island competition is 10, 20,10 shot on TSNZ targets. Make yourself aware of any special range conditions that could be announced at the Friday night briefing (another reason to attend). The range calls could be different to what you are used to, so be prepared. Check your targets for marking or adding errors when you have shot. (Remember a shot that has already been tested can't be retested.) Any queries on the marking should be brought to the attention of your Manager, who will forward your protest to the Chief Marker. The official protest time ends 10 mins after the final team score for your match has been posted.
