INFORMATION

Registration – Please register your team at the office when you first arrive. You will need to provide a <u>Team list and key Contact Person with mobile number</u>, plus <u>names of all your helpers/coaches</u> etc who will be attending - this is for Health & Safety purposes.

Gear tables – these will be labelled with School names. Best used with rifles on top, gear bags underneath, and rifle cases stacked on the shelves along the wall.

Armoury – Cased rifles can be stored securely at the MSRA Range, all other gear bags will need to be taken away. See Jackie to arrange this.

Mats – MSRA mats are available for use by all shooters.

Practices – will be held only on Friday 4pm – 8pm, Saturday 8am – 8.45am, and Sunday 8.15am – 8,45am. Please DO NOT shoot a full card, use a few diagrams only then vacate the mound.

Match timing – 20 minutes has been allowed between squads. This is to allow ample time for team turnaround and for coaches to get their shooters set up prior to shooting. Squad times may differ slightly from those pre-advertised, so be ready early.

Squad turnover – shooters for the next squad should wait on the bench seats. All shooters are to leave the range before the next squad enters, so please vacate mounds promptly.

Coaching / spotting – this can be done from <u>behind the mound only</u>. Keep instructions to the minimum during matches.

Protests – marking or match protests can be made at any time during the match by the Team Manager/Coach only, bring these to the office for consideration. No protests will be accepted later than 15 minutes after the last squad's scores have been provided for each match (eg 15 minutes after Squad 12 for Schools Match, 15 minutes after Squad 16 for the Island Match etc).

Plate Match – ALL shooters not in NZ teams take part in this match. If you have early travel arrangements see Jackie by 3pm on the SATURDAY to help with squadding.

Team Photos – these will be taken from 10am on Sunday. Teams may wear uniforms, mufti, or shooting jackets, as they choose.

Food – eat only in the social area please, not around gear, and wash hands with de-leading soap provided in the bathrooms first. Snacks, toasties and drinks will be available for purchase.
