**Prone Rifle National Classifications** (National Classifications) are awarded to individuals who have previously competed in a Prone Rifle Iron Sights Aggregate (Aggregate) at an NSRA National Rifle Meeting. An individual who, in the previous two years, has not entered the Bisley National Rifle Meeting or entered but did not fire all the targets in an Aggregate, without good reason, is deemed an 'Unclassified Competitor'. Therefore, unless advised otherwise by the NSRA, an entrant who did not compete in 2024 or 2025 is an 'Unclassified Competitor'.

Competitors at the 2024 & 2025 Bisley National Rifle Meeting will have been informed by the NSRA if they were promoted or demoted or if they lost their National Classification. Competitors who completed an Aggregate and were not informed otherwise will have a National Classification corresponding to the class in which they competed.

**Unclassified Prone Competitors**, those without a valid National Classification, must substantiate their class by submitting the average of the best 10 of their last 12 scores on British NSRA 1989 short range targets (ex. 100) or 50 metres/yards targets (integer score ex. 600). Averages from ISSF 50 metres rifle targets may also be submitted (integer score ex. 600).
