Top Ten shoot off (20 shot match) for OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP, possible 500.50

BCD Top Ten shoot off for LOWER GRADE CHAMPIONSHIP, possible 500.50

Re-entries in a higher grade permitted, but scores are not eligible for Top Ten shoot offs.

Any B, C, or D Grade shooter who also qualifies for the Open Top Ten will shoot in the Open squad, and that score will count for both shoot offs.

Course of fire to be confirmed, either

Two 10 shot cards at the Marlborough Championship, or subject to confirmation

One 10 shot card at each of the

- **Marlborough Open Championship**
- **Nelson Open Championship**
- **Saxton Championship**

Rifles used must be BSA Target rifles, fitted with Parker Hale, or similar open sights.

Similar era lever action Target rifles such as Vickers and Sportco are permitted.

Rifles must be consistent with the BSA era, and not unduly modified, specifically

- **No adjustable butts, either height or length, except factory manufacture**
- **No iris type rear or front sights, only PH discs**
- **No eagle eye front lens**

Permitted

- **Corrective rear lenses (eg shooting glasses, monoframe etc)**
- **Modern shooting jackets, slings, front rail, and handstops**
- **Modifications consistent with BSA era (eg thumbholes, carved cheekpieces etc)**
- **Other BSA era modifications at the discretion of the organisers.**
