2026 TSNZ Inter-Secondary Schools Inter Island Match

To be held at the Okoia Range, Whanganui and the Drayton Range, Christchurch

5th – 6th September 2026

Match Information

Schools' teams match

Team of three shooters from the same school, each shooting 3 x 10 shot cards. Up to two teams per school permitted. The winning team will be awarded individual medals and the Eddie Love Trophy, the top three individual shooters will receive medals, and all competitors will receive certificates.

Inter-Island teams match

The top 10 shooters from each Island, based on their scores in the Schools team match will qualify for their respective Island teams. The 11th and 12th scorers will be the team emergencies. All Island team members (including emergencies) will shoot 2 x 10 shot cards. The winning team will receive medals and the Ian Greenhough Memorial trophy.

New Zealand teams

The top 12 shooters, based on the aggregates of their scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match, will form the New Zealand team to shoot postal targets against Great Britain on Sunday morning. All team members will shoot 2 x 10 shot cards, with the top 10 shooters' scores to count for the team total.

Plate match

All shooters not involved in the New Zealand team match will be drawn into teams and shoot 2 x 10 shot matches for additional awards.

Individual awards

Trophies will be awarded to the top Girl and top Boy, based on the aggregates of scores in the Schools team match and the Inter-Island match.

General Information

Accommodation

Schools are responsible for arranging their own accommodation.

Range information

The ranges being used are both 20 mound, 25-yard ranges.

Okoia Range, 719 No.3 Line, Okoia, Whanganui. The range is part of the Okoia Hall complex.

Drayton Range, 11 Bangor Street, Christchurch, also referred to as the Bangor Street range.

There is no secure storage available at Okoia and limited at the Drayton range. Talk to the hosts for options.

Food and drink

Light snacks and drinks will be on sale at the Okoia range. Drayton ranges has 2 cafes close by and has food reheating available.

Sunday travel times

Hopefully all teams will be able to stay for the final presentations at approximately 12.45pm on Sunday. However, it is recognized that some teams may need to leave early to catch ferries or planes. In these cases, squadding will be arranged to facilitate this, with preference given to those with ferry or airline bookings.
