## South Island Association Teams Competition

**Saturday 25th July, Oamaru**

Hosted by the Associations of Christchurch, Ashley and North Canterbury

### **VENUE:**

Waitaki Community Recreation Centre, 43 Orwell Street, Oamaru.

There is limited parking around the Rec Centre. The car park beside the main entrance will have designated car parks that are for 5 minute drop off/pick up only, no parking.

Please do not walk through the Girls High School boarding complex (on Ouse St) beside the Rec Centre as a shortcut to the venue.

The team equipment set-up area is located in the large northern hall. There will be a large table set up for each association to use as their base for the weekend.

The 20yd range has 16 mounds set up in the southern hall. There is room at the back of the hall for the next round's competitors to wait with their gear. Competitors to please be here at least 5mins before the end of the previous round.

### **PROGRAMME:**

#### **Friday 24th July**

6.00 - 8.00pm Range open for Practice. (This may extend based on demand).

7.30pm South Island Association AGM, in the Aerobics' Room.

Please note, there is no Managers meeting Friday night. All correspondence will be by email right up to the day if any changes made. – So please check your emails.

#### **Saturday 25th July:**

**7.00am** Waitaki Rec Centre doors will be open.

**7.30am** First round of shooting starts.

**3.30pm (approx.)** TSNZ Shop closed

**5.45pm (approx.)** Approximate conclusion of Shooting.

**7.30pm** Dinner served prior to prizegiving at the Oamaru Club.

### **SHOOTING PROCEDURE:**

Athletes will shoot their **Double card round first**, then follow with a Single card later.

### **JUNIORS:**

For the A&F competition, the definition of a junior is they **must be under 21 years of age on the day of the event**, not until the end of the year as per TSNZ rules.

### **VOLUNTEERS TO RUN THE EVENT**

Each Association will be required to provide a minimum of two competent target markers at various times during the day. Once the initial squading has been issued, each association will be required to nominate their markers in the pre-rostered slots, prior to the event. Markers are required to be familiar with the "TSNZ Indoor Marking Procedures" booklet.

### **RIFLE SAFETY:**

Rifles are to be made safe when set up in the team equipment area, ie. Bolts open and breech flags in place. Breech flags must be fitted when carrying rifles to the mound and must be fitted before removing rifles from the mound and returning to the equipment area. Remember to point your rifle in a "safe direction" when walking between the halls.

### **TSNZ SHOP:**

The TSNZ shop will be set up in the Aerobics' Room on Saturday, till about mid-afternoon. This is a great opportunity to browse for your next new rifle or latest gadgets.

### **FOOD:**

There will be food available for purchase (cash only) in the kitchen all day Saturday, with the usual caterers. This year a coffee van will also be on site, (with EFTPOS) in the main entrance carpark from 7am to about 4.30pm, depending on demand. Decaf is also available. Please support them.

### **RAFFLES:**

There will be raffles available to help support the running of this event. We would appreciate your support. Each raffle will be drawn once all tickets sold, or at conclusion of shooting.

### **PRIZEGIVING:**

The prizegiving dinner will be held in the function room at the Oamaru Club, 32 Severn Street. The function room has its own bar. Doors open 7pm, with dinner at 7.30pm. Prizegiving will be start between the Mains and Dessert.

Coloured wrist bands will be given out to those previously nominated to attend the dinner. No wrist band = no dinner. This will be checked.

Dress code is semi-formal with NZ blazers to be worn for those that have them.
